<p>-Take SAT I or Subject test, and/or ACT -Go over all draft applications and essays with parents, teachers and your counselor -Finish college applications -Send college applications (make a copy)</p>	<p>-Complete your income taxes early (or Estimate) -Fill out the FAFSA and submit to federal processor (make copies) in October -Fill out and send any other financial aid applications (make copies) -Check w/colleges on their financial aid deadlines -Send test scores (if not previously sent)</p>	<p>-Have all necessary forms for financial aid been sent? -C.C. Office will mail Mid-year grades to Colleges -Write thank you notes to teachers for their recommendations</p>
