

2021-2022 Course Selection Instructions

(for current Grade 9 students)

General Information

- **Course selection will take place online from April 8 - 19.**
- The 2021-2022 Program of Studies is available on the Portal and the Bishop Brady website. Please note these areas:
 - Page 6 – requirements for graduation
 - Page 12 – new course for next year
 - Page 64 – updated Limited Homework courses
 - Courses not offered during the 2021-2022 academic year will be indicated at the end of the course summary and will not be available for selection in the online form.
- Most students will register for 7 full credits for the academic year.
- Ensure you've met/will meet the NH **and** BBHS Graduation Requirements for specific courses and overall credits. If you have questions, double-check with your school counselor.
- Pay attention to course prerequisites – if you do not meet them, have a conversation with your current teacher and counselor BEFORE selecting the course to determine if it will be possible.
- Forms requesting Alternative Coursework, Advanced Placement (AP) courses, Fine Arts Credit, Physical Education Credit, and Sports Participation must be printed, signed, and returned to the School Counseling Office when you complete your course selection process. Blank forms will be available in the SCO.
- Teachers and counselors will review your course selections and must approve your choices.
- If online course selection is NOT complete by April 19, your counselor will select your courses for you and you may not receive priority in scheduling.
- A student's schedule for the 2021-2022 academic year will not be finalized unless a 2021-2022 Enrollment Contract is signed and returned.

Grade-specific Information

- All students must select the following:
 - Understanding Scriptures (#1020) for their Theology course – 1 credit
 - A World Language course based on their current course/level – 1 credit
 - A Math course based on their current course/level – 1 credit
 - World Literature (CP #7020 / Honors #7022) – 1 credit
 - World History (CP #8010 / Honors #8012 **and** #8013) – 1 credit
 - A Science course based on their current course/level – 1 credit

Students may select other courses that are required for graduation (i.e., Civics, Wellness, a Fine


****NOTE: For all "core" subjects (Math, English, Science), select the course level you are currently in** (i.e., you are currently in CP Math, so choose a CP Math course for next year). Level changes will be done at a future date with approval of teachers, curriculum facilitators, counselors, and parents.

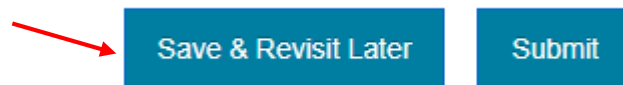
4. Start course selection with the first GROUP: Theology

↓ Group 1 - Theology

Theology Courses
All students must complete 4 credits in Theology to graduate.

- Grade 9 – Foundations of Catholicism
- Grade 10 – Understanding Scriptures
- Grades 11 & 12 – Moral Theology I, Moral Theology II, plus two electives

5. Proceed through all the offered GROUPS until you have completed your course selections.
6. You have the option to **SAVE & REVISIT LATER** or **SUBMIT** as you’re ready. Once you select **SUBMIT**, you can no longer alter your selections – we recommend using the **SAVE & REVISIT LATER** option until you’re completely sure about your course selections.



7. All students are required to take 4 years of Theology and 4 years of English, so if you haven’t selected the necessary course(s) in those GROUPS, you’ll be prompted to do so.
